(III) Elective Courses: 22 credits

1. The department offers 20 credits of electives from other departments, including a maximum of 6 credits for elective courses offered by the General Education Center (including a maximum of 4 credits for physical education courses).
2. Military training courses of national defense education for all people are not included in the calculation of graduation credits.

Notes :

1. Blocking courses

(1) If the total score of "Orthopedic Physical Therapy and Practicum( I )" and "Clinical Practicum in Physical Therapy and Clinical Decision Making( I )" is not 60 points, the students will be denied the compulsory course "Clinical Practicum in Physical Therapy and Clinical Decision Making( II)".

(2) "Anatomy(Including Lab)( I )", "Anatomy(Including Lab)( II )", "Physiology and Laboratory( I )", "Physiology and Laboratory( II )", "Physical Agent Therapy and Practicum( I )", "Physical Agent Therapy and Practicum( II )", "Basic Techniques of Physical Therapy and Practicum", "Manual Therapy and Practicum", "Orthopedic Physical Therapy and Practicum( I )", "Orthopedic Physical Therapy and Practicum( II )", "Pediatric Physical Therapy and Practicum", "Neurological Physical Therapy and Practicum( I )", "Neurological Physical Therapy and Practicum( II )", "Cardiopulmonary Physical Therapy and Practicum", "Clinical Practicum in Physical Therapy and Clinical Decision Making( I )", "Clinical Practicum in Physical Therapy and Clinical Decision Making( II )", If the total score of the above 16 subjects is less than 60 points, the compulsory courses of the major will be blocked: Clinical Practicum ( I ), Clinical Practicum ( II ), Clinical Practicum ( III ), Clinical Practicum ( IV ), Clinical Practicum ( V ) and Clinical Practicum ( VI ).

2. There are no summer courses for the third-year block course.

3. If study the necessary credit courses for the second specialty, all of them can be recognized as graduation credits.

4. In addition to completing the required credits for graduation, other graduation requirements must also meet school's academic rules before they are qualified for graduation.
